VISITOR'S TAX

Dear guests,

Welcome to the Obergoms region. We are delighted that you have decided to spend your holiday here. We already wish you a great stay with many unforgettable and enjoyable moments.

With regard to the visitor's tax, in accordance with the new regulations set out by the Goms and Obergoms municipalities, we would like to inform you that from 1 November the rate for adults is increasing from CHF 2.50 per night to CHF 3.00. For children from 6 to 16 years, the visitor's tax will be CHF 1.50. Children up to 6 years old still pay no visitor's tax. The owner of the object pays the visitor's tax to the authorities as a lump sum and is allowed to collect the visitor's tax from the tenants.

The new regulations have been introduced alongside the issuing of the new guest card "Discovery Pass", with which we invite you to discover and experience the region. Visit authentic villages and enjoy a true journey of discovery through the history and stories of the Obergoms region. Information about the many services included with the Discovery Pass is available on www.obergoms.ch.

Apart from the introduction of the new guest card, the increase in the visitor's tax rate also finances measures to improve the tourist infrastructure, contributing to the financing of over 60 kilometres of winter walking paths and various summer and winter facilities.

The tourist information offices in Oberwald, Münster, Reckingen and Blitzingen will also be happy to help with your holiday planning and to provide advice for pleasant holidays in the Goms region.
